

## NAPIM Food Packaging Committee – Exclusion List 2017

The purpose of this list is to provide a convenient reference to typical printer/convertor/brand owner certification requests. This listing has no regulatory applicability under the US Food and Drug Administration regulations.

Specifically, this “Exclusion List” spreadsheet lists chemical compounds are frequently specified by printers/converters/brands for exclusion from the food packaging supply chain because of known or suspected adverse health impacts.

- International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC)  
Chemical substances classified by IARC – Groups 1-3
